## **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Discussion of the intersection of Skelp Level Rd and Winchester Trail

Discussion ensued with regards to the intersection. Residents complaint that increasing the speed from 25 MPH to 35 MPH will cause issues with the residents exiting Winchester. Township Engineer Lucas will research ideas to increase signage and pavement markings. Traffic Committee recommends implementing them incrementally.

2. Discussion of the intersection of Strasburg Rd. (Route 162) and Highland Rd.

Discussion ensued. Township Engineer Lucas briefed the steps taken and the possible solutions.

Traffic Committee made the recommendation to the Board of Supervisors as follows. Motion made by Ken Cavanaugh and seconded by Laura Pitts:

Have the Township Engineer do the following:

- Approach property owner Jacob Singer with a proposal to shave back the embankment for increased visibility.
- Approach the new owner on the opposite corner with recommendations for improving sight distance. Recommendations to follow from Engineer.
- Research new signage and possible pavement markings for the intersection.
