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## *Job Title: Public Works Laborer – Unskilled*

**Department:** Public Works

**Supervises:** None

### **Position Summary**

The Public Works Unskilled Laborer position performs a variety of tasks related to the Township infrastructure, facilities and buildings involving the operation of vehicles, equipment, and tools.

### **Qualifications Required**

- Pennsylvania CDL license Class B with airbrake endorsement (or will need to obtain Pennsylvania CDL license Class B with airbrake endorsement within 90 days of hire)

### **Qualifications Desired**

- High school diploma or its equivalent
- Post-high school voc-tech certification in a related field
- Trench shoring and confined spaces training certifications
- CPR and/or first aid certifications
- LTAP certifications
- LTAP Road Scholar Certification
- Flagger certification

### **Essential Functions & Responsibilities**

- Operate manual, pneumatic, and power maintenance tools with supervision
- Operate light and medium equipment with supervision
- Repair and maintain roads with asphalt, hot/cold patching, and sealant materials
- Erect and repair guiderail, signs, and channeling devices
- Perform traffic control setup for work sites
- Paint stop bars and traffic lines
- Clean out storm drains, pipes, streams, and flood control structures
- Clean and repair catch basins, culverts, and storm drains
- Load and unload materials and tools from trucks
- Clean and store tools and equipment after use
- Respond to emergency situations
- Remove fallen trees from roadways and trim low lying limbs from streets
- Participate in winter storm operations, including operating snow plow equipment and applying anti-skid materials to clear public roadways
- Control vegetation by mowing, weed whacking, weeding, and pruning
- Apply mulch to planting beds, playgrounds, and other areas
- Collect trash and refuse from Township facilities, parks, and trails
- Clean Township facilities (park facilities, park restrooms)
- Complete small carpentry, painting, and other improvement projects

- Submit weekly time sheets to the Public Works Director
- Adhere to regulations and safety standards
- Receive feedback (e.g. comments, complaints, suggestions) from the public and communicate feedback to the Public Works Foreman or Public Works Director
- Routinely survey streets, roads, pavements, parks, trails, and other Township facilities and report needs and/or deficiencies to the Public Works Director or Public Works Foreman

- Assists with vehicle and equipment maintenance and repair
- Operate heavy equipment with supervision

- Knowledge of materials, methods, and tools and practices involved in the construction or repair of streets, roads, pavements, parks, trails, recreation areas, and storm water management systems
- Knowledge of arithmetic (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, decimals)
- Knowledge of machines and tools, including their designs, uses, repair, and maintenance

### **Physical Demands & Work Environment**

- **Physical Demands:** While performing the duties of this job, the employee is occasionally required to stand, walk, use hands to find, handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to sit, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, talk, hear and smell. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move weights of 50 pounds or more. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
- **Work Environment:** While performing the essential duties of this position, the employee is continuously exposed a variety of indoor and outdoor conditions. Some work is performed in office settings while other work will expose the employee to outdoor weather conditions. The employee is frequently working near moving mechanical parts and is exposed to fumes or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals, risks of electrical shock and vibration. The noise level ranges from moderate to very loud depending upon the location and type of work being performed.
