

On December 28, 2021, at 12:00 noon prevailing time, at the East Bradford Township Building, 676 Copeland School Road, West Chester, PA, the Board of Supervisors of East Bradford Township will hold a public hearing to consider and thereafter act upon an Ordinance to include members of the Board of Supervisors in Township group health, hospitalization and medical plans in accordance with the Second Class Township Code. Section 1 of the Ordinance describes the benefits; Section 2 provides that benefits shall not be provided to any supervisor or dependents until the 2023 budget year and thereafter; and the benefits shall not accrue to any supervisor or dependents, if such supervisor is currently seated and acting upon this Ordinance, until the beginning of the next term of such supervisor. Section 3 provides for compensation deductions; Section 4 provides for severability; and Section 5 provides for effective date. ORDINANCE _____
EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP

**AN ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF
SUPERVISORS IN TOWNSHIP GROUP HEALTH, HOSPITALIZATION AND
MEDICAL PLANS**

SECTION 1: INSURANCE BENEFIT. Members of the Board of Supervisors, whether or not they are employed by the Township, and their dependents are eligible for inclusion in group health, hospitalization and medical plans paid in whole or in part by the Township pursuant to Section 606 (c) of the Second Class Township Code.

SECTION 2: IMPLEMENTATION OF BENEFIT. The benefits provided under this Ordinance shall not be provided to any supervisor or dependents until the 2023 budget year and thereafter; and the benefits shall not accrue to any supervisor or dependents, if such supervisor is currently seated and acting upon this Ordinance, until the beginning of the next term of such supervisor.

SECTION 3: COMPENSATION DEDUCTION. The Township may deduct from any compensation payable to a supervisor such part of any insurance premium or charge which is payable by the supervisor within the terms of the particular insurance plan.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of East Bradford Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after enactment as by law provided.
